- **10.2020 Preliminaries** The Chair welcomed everyone to the meeting. There were no apologies.
- **11.2020** Declarations of Interest There were no declarations of interest

16.2020 Directors' Self-Assessment Report and Quality Improvement Plan

Directors considered the Self-Assessment report and progress made against the Quality Improvement Plan for 2020-21. The Principal gave an update on **Issue 1:** Directors knowledge of the college's curriculum offer - training for directors had been prepared by the Assistant Principal: Vocational however due to current coronavirus situation and despite the expected progress date of July, it was agreed to leave the training until September and present at the Standards Board meeting.

It was agreed directors will also receive an update on lost learning for students.

Issue 2: Staff workload is maintained at realistic levels - directors were informed that the staff survey had been issued and over 179 responses returned which is approximately 83%, the highest it's ever been. The Principal informed directors that the feedback from staff during lockdown had been really positive so she feels confident the staff survey results will reflect this. The final report will be shared at the Corporation meeting in July. The Principal also stated that all staff had worked extremely hard over the last few months and continue to support all students.

The Principal gave an update on the current situation which included the phased return to college. SLT are meeting to discuss how measures can be introduced to ensure safe social distancing measures.

It was noted that 96% of the college funding comes from ESFA which means funding is guaranteed.
