Create a research page about your primary visit add evidence such as photos, leaflets etc:

: Consider writing a reflection or analysis of the exhibition and how it could influence your photography. This can help you process your thoughts and articulate your insights. Contextual visits also support your A01 marks.

Things to consider to write about:

- Where did you go and why?
- What did you get out of the day?
- What inspired you?
- What things did you focus on when photographing?
- How will you use this primary evidence to develop your project?
